

EMERGENCY E-MAIL VOTE

On October 1, 2020 the Reading Edge Academy, Inc. Governing Board was contacted by e-mail for an emergency vote to close one classroom at Reading Edge Academy in Debary starting Friday, October 2, 2020, and reopening Monday October 12, 2020. This was recommended by the Florida Department of Health in Volusia County due to one case of COVID-19 found in one classroom only. The classroom will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized and the o-zone machine will be placed in the room over the weekend. Students can return to the classroom if they have not become symptomatic.

Because an immediate approval by the Governing Board was needed, an emergency vote was requested by e-mail by Principal Peggy Comardo.

A motion to accept the Health Department's recommendation to close the classroom affected due to Covid-19 from October 2 to October 12, 2020 was made by Chairman Mike Caldwell. The motion was seconded by Member Sandy Kent. The motion passed 5- 0 with Mr. Caldwell, Mrs. Foster, Mrs. Stanley, Mrs. Lowery, and Mrs. Kent approving this measure.
